In the spirit of IABSE, contributions on buildings, bridges and any other civil engineering structure and in any material are welcome. In due time, you are asked to prepare either a 10 minutes presentation or a poster on A1 format. All presentations are in **English**.

IABSE offers a platform for structural engineers to exchange information and to learn from each other at the international level.
